Camp Descriptions:

Outdoor Explorers Camp: (for students who have recently finished 4th, 5th, 6th, or 7th grade):

You'll find life-long friends and life-long memories at Long Lake. This Explorer session is filled with outdoor activities, games, and enjoying the camp community. Canoeing, archery, bog trekking, hiking, orienteering, the Challenge Cooperation Course, and much more are led by fun counselors ("They're really nice," campers say) and naturalists. You won't want to miss this!

Forkhorn I Camp: (Age 11-16, and do NOT already have their Firearm Safety Certificate)

The Forkhorn I camp is designed for beginning hunters and provides extensive hands-on instruction in basic firearms safety, shooting techniques in rifle, shotgun, muzzleloaders, and archery. They also provide hunting tips for both big and small game. MN Department of Natural Resources **Firearm Safety Certification** is part of this camp. Classes include: Firearm Safety / Beginning Rifle, Shotgun, and Archery / Wildlife Mgmt / Whitetail Deer Ecology / Hunter Ethics, Compass Orienteering / Deer Hunting Techniques / Safe Shooting Scenarios / Outdoor Survival

Forkhorn II Camp: Open to all youth ages 12-16.

Forkhorn II is an advanced camp for youth who are graduates of Forkhorn I Camp or have completed their Firearm Safety Training. It's a more intensive camp that takes students beyond basic whitetail deer hunting knowledge and strategies, providing them with advanced training in the areas of: Bow hunting / Map and compass / Game preparation / Marksmanship training / Ethical hunting practices / Big game ecology / Special hunting techniques.

Students will be certified in the **Minnesota Bow Hunter Education Program** as part of the camp.

July 18-23, 2010 **\$425.00**

♦ Participants must have recently completed grades 4, 5, 6, or 7 in order to attend this camp. Campers are grouped according to grade/age.

July 11-16, 2010 **\$400.00**

August 1-6, 2010 **\$400.00**

August 8-13, 2010 **\$400.00**

♦ Participants must **NOT** have their Firearm Safety Certificate prior to attending this camp.

July 25-30, 2010 **\$400.00**

♦ Participants must be 12 years old by the start of this camp and must already have their Firearm Safety Certificate.
♦ Campers must **NOT** already have their Bow-hunters Safety Certificate.
