Brief Scenario: Friday evening arrival between 4 pm and bedtime. Friday evening will include a social time to get acquainted. Cookies and non-alcoholic beverages will be provided. All workshops, demonstrations, classes and field trips to local attractions will be scheduled throughout the weekend based on what attendees are seeking. Each attendee can select which topics they wish to address. There is plenty of opportunity for one on one learning with the instructor. One of the Spring retreat attractions is the Sharptail Grouse blind near the center. The Sharptail Grouse perform their 'mating' dance during the month of April each year.

Each morning, activities will start at sun-rise to capture photos of nature at dawn. This will be followed by brunch. From there, the fun & learning really begins! There will be activities for everyone from the beginner photographer to the very experienced. This retreat is your chance to get away and focus on one thing... photography. Both film and digital users are welcome; Many topics are fitting to both. (Note: Film developing is available at Aitkin, MN - approx. 20 miles from the Center).

A full list of activities will not be available until shortly before the retreat; Some of the guests will also be presenters. **The idea behind this retreat is to share and learn from each other.** There will be at least one professional photographer at the retreat with several presentations ready to go.
